SEQUENCE 1

Scene 1

Ready for battle

Scene 2

One shot isn't enough

Scene 2 – One shot isn't enough

Major Boyd

Speaks with a slight exertion in his voice.

[via radio – David Pressman can be seen from the front and how he is looking through the scope of his sniper rifle.]

(2-01) "Command Center, target acquired. We have a clean line of fire, over."

Command Center

Commanding tone with insistence.

[via radio – You can see David Pressman and Major Boyd from the left, standing on a balcony. (Camera is zooming in.)]

(2-02) "You're cleared to engage, Major. I repeat: Neutralize target!"

Major Boyd

Speaks with exertion in his voice.

[via radio – View through the sniper's scope.]

(2-03) "Roger, Command Center. On stand-by!"

Dmitry Tarassov

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – Dmitry is walking up the stairs, stops in the middle of the room and turns to Sergey.]

(2-04) "The men are set and ready, Sergey."

Sergey Volkov

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – Sergey turns to Dmitry...]

(2-05) "Good..."

[...shortly after this a shot is fired.]

Russian soldier

Typical, hysterical screaming while in combat.

[Russian accent – The shot misses its target and hits a soldier who drops down the stairs.]

(2-06) "Fuck! – Sniper fire! Sniper fire!"

[Russian accent – Soldier 1 is standing at the window and opens fire.]

(2-07) "Get Sergey out of here!"

Russian guard 1

No screaming, but the order is being confirmed with insistence and slightly shouting.

[Russian accent – Guard 2 walks out of his cover and opens fire, too.]

(2-08) "Okay..."

[Russian accent – Guard 1 is passing by the window and runs towards the stairs.]

(2-09) "...we'll get him out!"

David Pressman

Angry, cursing manner of speaking.

[Pressman can be seen in a close-up shot while lowering his rifle.]

(2-10) "Fuck! – I screwed up!"

Russian soldier

Commanding tone with exertion in the voice.

[Russian accent, via radio – Soldier 1 barricaded himself in a corner of the house.]

(2-11) "On my orders: Code red! I repeat: We're on code red!"

Major Boyd

Tense and hectic manner of speaking.

[via radio – The major walks into the house and contacts the Command Center.]

(2-12) "Command Center, this is Major Boyd – the Weasel was negative on effect! Over."

Command Center

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[via radio – You can see two Russian guards flanking the door.]

(2-13) "This is Command Center, please repeat, over."

Major Boyd

Tense and hectic manner of speaking.

[via radio – You can see Dmitry and Sergey running out of the house, past the Russian guards.]

(2-14) "The Weasel was negative on effect. I repeat: Target is NOT neutralized! Over."

Command Center

Commanding tone with insistence.

[via radio – The US troops which are in waiting position are shown.]

(2-15) "Affirmative, Major. You've got the go-ahead on directive *Thunder-clap*, over."

Major Boyd

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[via radio – Major Boyd can be seen inside the house while he walks outside onto the balcony.]

(2-16) "Roger that, Command Center. Executing orders, out."

[Outside the range of the enemy snipers Sergey and Dmitry are safe inside the house across the street. They are planning on what to do next.]

Dmitry Tarassov

Serious and worried manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – You can see Sergey and Dmitry.]

(2-17) "You really need to leave, Sergey. It's too dangerous for you."

Sergey Volkov

Angry and a bit furious manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – Close-up shot of Sergey.]

(2-18) "And run away like a coward?"

Dmitry Tarassov

Understanding but insistent manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – Both can be seen.]

(2-19) "You need to seek shelter, my friend. You are way too important for us all and even more for *Cold Star*."

Sergey Volkov

Angry and a bit furious manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – Close-up shot of Sergey. Dmitry interrupts him.]

(2-20) "I've never run away and I don't plan..."

Dmitry Tarassov

Speaks with exertion in his voice.

[Russian accent – Close-up shot of Dmitry.]

(2-21) "Nobody is asking you to run away. God damn it..."

[Russian accent – Both can be seen.]

(2-22) "...YOU are *Cold Star*! And right now it's way too dangerous here for you."

Sergey Volkov

The manner of speaking changes from annoyed to soft.

[Russian accent – Both can be seen, but the camera is focused on Sergey.]

(2-23) "Well, maybe you are right."

Dmitry Tarassov

Speaks with a calm voice, appealing to their friendship.

[Russian accent – Both can be seen, but the camera is focused on Dmitry.]

(2-24) "Trust me, I am. We are perfectly prepared; the Americans will have no chance at all."

Sergey Volkov

Speaks with a calm, almost warm-hearted voice.

[Russian accent – At first a close-up shot of Sergey and then both can be seen.]

(2-25) "But I won't leave without you, my friend; because you are also too important."

Dmitry Tarassov

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – Close-up shot of Dmitry.]

(2-26) "Alright, so we are agreed on this point."

[Russian accent – Dmitry turns to the soldier on his left.]

(2-27) "Get the helo ready! We are moving Sergey out of here."

Russian guard 1

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – Guard 1 gets up and runs to the door.]

(2-28) "Yes, sir!"

Dmitry Tarassov

Playful manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – Sergey and Dmitry can be seen.]

(2-29) "For god's sake, why have you to be so damn stubborn?"

Sergey Volkov

Playful manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – Both can be seen.]

(2-30) "And why the hell are you such a loyal idiot?"

[They look at each other and laugh. Afterwards Dmitry turns left and exits the building. Sergey and the second guard follow him.]

Russian guard 2

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Russian accent, via radio – The Russian guards are shown in the Mi-24 Hind on a Close-up shot.]

(2-31) "Wolfeagle is ready to go."

[Russian accent, via radio – The helicopter rises into the skies.]

(2-32) "We're getting Sergey and Dmitry back to the base."

Valentin Komarov

Convinced and optimistic manner of speaking.

[Russian accent, via radio – The Hind turns by 90°.]

(2-33) "Alright. Our commander won't be disappointed!"

Sergey Volkov

Serious and worried manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – The helicopter flies in northwest direction.]

(2-34) "It's the baptism of fire for my guys."

Dmitry Tarassov

Convinced and optimistic manner of speaking.

[Russian accent]

(2-35) "And they'll get through it."

[Russian accent – Fadeout to black.]

(2-36) "You will see."
