Scene 7 – The trail leads to Arica Harbor

Bad Company

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[The US Team has survived Sergey's attack and moves through the thick smoke of the explosions towards the viewer. Text fading in: Operation Base "Grizzly" | June 13th, 2011 – 9:30 AM]

(7-01) [Due to the awirl dust the characters are coughing.]

Peter Young O'Connell

Easy and joking manner of speaking.

[Finally the team comes to stop and can be seen in a Wide shot from the front.]

(7-02) "With all due respect: This Sergey doesn't do things by halves."
[laughs playfully]

William Stanford Brown

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Now the team can be seen in a Figure shot from behind.]

(7-03) "Yeah, this base is lost for sure, Sir."

Colonel Maxwell

Serious and a bit worried manner of speaking.

[The team is still being shown from behind, however the camera moves from the left to the right.]

(7-04) "And also this mission if we are not able to find a proper replacement."

William Stanford Brown

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[A part of the group can be seen in a Full shot, Captain Brown stands to the left.]

(7-05) "Sir, let's check on the current status first and find out what's left over."

Colonel Maxwell

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Again a part of the group is seen, this time from the perspective of the Colonel, who stands at the right side.]

(7-06) "Alright, Captain, let's have a closer view on this situation."

Normal commanding tone.

[The group is moved to a hall and had positioned in a circle. The Colonel can be seen in a Close-up shot from the front.]

(7-07) "We should split up into two groups."

[The Colonel and a part of the group can be seen from behind.]

(7-08) "Rodriguez, Tipps and McClark, this hall is yours, the rest follows me."

Francisco Rodriguez

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[The US Team can be seen in a Figure shot.]

(7-09) "Roger that, Sir!"

[McClark, Rodriguez and Tipps can be seen in a Medium close-up from the front.]

(7-10) "Guys, this doesn't look good."

[The three soldiers stand at the entrance of the hall, a heavily damaged Humvee can be seen to the right of the picture.]

(7-11) "Let's take a closer look."

[Francisco stands in front of the Humvee and takes a closer look at it.]

(7-12) "This crate is totally done for. Even I can't do anything about it."

J. P. McClark

Easy and joking manner of speaking.

[J. P. is crouching down and moves around the car to examine it.]

(7-13) "Mhm... another scrap for the war museum, I'd say."

[J. P. is arrived at the back of the car and gets up again.]

(7-14) "Ha, the spare tire is still okay." [laughs jokingly]

Colonel Maxwell

Serious and worried manner of speaking.

[Colonel Maxwell and Captain Brown are on their way to hall 3.]

(7-15) "Captain, I seriously consider to abort the mission."

William Stanford Brown

Surprised and a little disconcerted manner of speaking.

[Same recording as before.]

(7-16) "But Sir, with all due respect: You can't do that."

Colonel Maxwell

Serious and worried manner of speaking.

[Same recording as before.]

(7-17) "Maybe I have to, Captain, maybe I have to."

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Close-up shot of the Colonel from the front.]

(7-18) "So, what's it like?"

Peter Young O'Connell

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[The group can be seen in a Medium close-up.]

(7-19) "The two Humvees are damaged but can be repaired."

Francisco Rodriguez

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Francisco walks up to the Colonel and then stops.]

(7-20) "Sir, we are done with the inspection."

Colonel Maxwell

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[The Colonel turns around to Francisco.]

(7-21) "So what's the result, Sergeant?"

Francisco Rodriguez

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[The US Team can be seen in a Figure shot.]

(7-22) "Not a single Humvee is operational anymore. No chance to fix them."

[Rodriguez, Tipps and the Colonel can be seen in an American shot from the front (left side), but the camera is focused on Francisco.]

(7-23) "But I can fix the Abrams, Sir."

Colonel Maxwell

Normal commanding tone.

[Rodriguez, Tipps and the Colonel can be seen in an American shot from the front (right side), but the camera is focused on Maxwell.]

(7-24) "Start right away and fix the Humvees first, they have top priority."

Francisco Rodriguez

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[McClark, Rodriguez, Tipps and Maxwell are being shown in a Full shot from the front.]

(7-25) "Yes, Sir!"

[Francisco turns to the left to Jason.]

(7-26) "Jason, you and J. P. can assist me."

Jason Tipps

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[McClark, Rodriguez and Tipps can be seen in an American shot from the front (left side).]

(7-27) "Alright, we'll do so."

Francisco Rodriguez

Playful and stitching manner of speaking.

[Francisco walks up to Peter and addresses him.]

(7-28) "And both of you can help me too. Do you think you can handle that?"

Peter Young O'Connell

Convinced and optimistic manner of speaking.

[Francisco passes by Peter and walks up to the hall. The others follow him. Afterwards fadeout to black.]

(7-29) "No problem at all."

[Black picture and text fading in: 9 hours later.]

Colonel Maxwell

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Colonel Maxwell and Captain Brown are on their way to hall 3 where the Humvees get repaired.]

(7-30) "Well, let's check on our Sergeant's progress. We are running out of time."

[The Colonel stands at the entrance of the hall and looks at the Humvee to the right which is still being repaired.]

(7-31) "So, how far did you get?"

Francisco Rodriguez

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Same recording as before, afterwards the Colonel and the Sergeant can be seen in a Medium close-up.]

(7-32) "This crate was a half wreck. We still need three to four hours."

Jason Tipps

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Jason sits on the roof of the Humvee and repairs the machine gun.]

(7-33) "The fifty is almost ready, Sir."

J. P. McClark

Easy and joking manner of speaking.

[You can see McClark crouching left to the Humvee.]

(7-34) "The door seems to be upside down – but we can do it."

Colonel Maxwell

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[The Colonel, Francisco, Jason and J. P. are being shown how they stand around the Humvee.]

(7-35) "Alright."

[Same recording as before, afterwards the Colonel turns left.]

(7-36) "And what's your progress?"

Alan Young

Playful and stitching manner of speaking.

[Alan and Peter stand left to the Humvee.]

(7-37) "We are done for hours already, Sir, and twiddle our thumbs."

Colonel Maxwell

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[The Colonel approaches the Captain who stands to the left next of him.]

(7-38) "Captain, I will further investigate on the current situation in town. You stay and have an eye on the progress here."

William Stanford Brown

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Colonel Maxwell and Captain Brown are being shown. After this, the Colonel turns left and starts walking while the Captain walks into the hall.]

(7-39) "Roger that, Sir."

Colonel Maxwell

Calm and whispering manner of speaking (speaking to himself).

[Maxwell goes to the beach and can be seen from behind at the sea. Afterwards fadeout to black.]

(7-40) "How should this go on? Is the mission still on track and possible or should I terminate it? But to give up now would mean to surrender to our enemy."

[The US tipster Pablo Garcia has discovered unusual activities in Panama. He watches several men loading illegal weapons onto a containership. Text fading in: Puerto de Balboa, Panama Canal | June 13th, 2011 – 11:32 PM]

Russian Soldier 1

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – View over the shoulder of the tipster from behind (right side) while he is scanning the area with a night vision goggles.]

(7-41) "Everything on schedule?"

Russian Soldier 2

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – Same recording as before.]

(7-42) "Yeah, we are right on and will be able to set sail at the desired time."

Russian Soldier 1

Serious manner of speaking, with a noticeable worry in his voice.

[Russian accent – Same recording as before; Pablo lowers the night vision goggles.]

(7-43) "If this doesn't work out Sergey will kick our asses!"

Patrol 3 (Soldier 1)

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Russian accent, via radio – Patrol 3 checks if everything is in order on the roof of the building at point C.]

(7-44) "This is Patrol Three, Sector Four is all quiet. Over."

Patrol 3 (Soldier 2)

Relaxed and easygoing manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – Both guards have left the building and can be seen in a Wide shot from the front (right side) as they proceed their way.]

(7-45) "No Yank has the balls to show up here."

Patrol 3 (Soldier 1)

Taunting, cynical manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – Same recording as before.]

(7-46) "No way, he would be dead at the drop of a hat."

Russian Guard 2

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Russian accent, via radio – Both guards at hall 1 are shown from a bird's-eye view from the front (left side).]

(7-47) "This is Post One, status green. No activities to perceive."

[Russian accent, via radio – Both guards can be seen in a Medium close-up from the front (right side).]

(7-48) "We'll get back to you if something's changing. Over and out."

Pablo Garcia

Serious and worried manner of speaking.

[The tipster can be seen in a Medium close-up from the front.]

(7-49) "God dammit, that doesn't look good."

Russian Guard 2

Thoughtful manner of speaking (speaking to himself).

[Russian accent – Guard 2 moves up to the scout spot of the tipster.]

(7-50) "Shit, there was something moving!"

Speaks clearly and with insistence.

[Russian accent – Guard 2 stands at the foot of the stairs and braces the tipster.]

(7-51) "What the hell are you doing here?"

Pablo Garcia

Serious manner of speaking, with a noticeable worry in his voice.

[Pablo Garcia turns right towards the guard. Afterwards he can be seen in an American shot from the front.]

(7-52) "I'm from the port authority. I have no records about a ship being loaded at this time. I'm just doing my duty and need to see your papers."

Russian Guard 2

Speaks clearly and with insistence.

[Russian accent – Same recording as before.]

(7-53) "Ah, really? Do you think I'm retarded?"

Pablo Garcia

Serious manner of speaking, with a noticeable worry in his voice.

[Same recording as before.]

(7-54) "No, not at all. Please verify by yourself."

Russian Guard 1

Exhorting, forceful manner of speaking.

[Russian accent, via radio – The building where the tipsters scout spot is located is being shown in a Wide shot.]

(7-55) "Where are you, man? I thought you just wanted quickly check upon something."

Russian Guard 2

Speaks clearly and with insistence.

[Russian accent, via radio – The tipster and the guard 1 can be seen within the building.]

(7-56) "I've found an uninvited guest. Get over here!"

Russian Guard 1

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Russian accent, via radio – Same recording as before.]

(7-57) "Okay, I'm on my way."

Russian Guard 2

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Russian accent, via radio – Guard 2 is being shown in an American shot from the right.]

(7-58) "I will have a look if someone from the local port authority is still on duty. Meanwhile, you will guard our guest."

Russian Guard 1

Speaks clearly and with a slight insistence.

[Russian accent, via radio – Guard 1 walks to the building where the tipster got busted.]

(7-59) "Okay, got it."

Russian Guard 2

Speaks clearly and with insistence.

[Russian accent – The tipster and the first guard can be seen within the building while the second one stands in front of the house.]

(7-60) "Don't let this guy get away, you hear me? I'll be right back in a minute and then he's in for it."

Russian Guard 1

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – Same recording as before.]

(7-61) "Alright, see you soon!"

Russian Soldier 1

Coldhearted and accounting manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – Three Russian soldiers can be seen in an American shot how they stand side by side in a circle.]

(7-62) "Yeah, we are done. Time to cover our tracks and get out of here."

Russian Guard 2

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – View on the ship, guard 2 walks up to his Russian comrades which have finished loading the weapons.]

(7-63) "Hey, guys, we've pinned down an unwanted guest. He claims to be from the port authority."

Russian Soldier 1

Speaks snidely and with insistence.

[Russian accent – The group can be seen in a Figure shot from behind (right side).]

(7-64) "Total bullshit! No one from the port authority is around here at this time."

Patrol 1 (Soldier 1)

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Russian accent, via radio – After Pablo Garcia has killed the guard he sneaks along a concrete barrier and sees a patrol in front of him. After this, you can see the patrol moving along the street.]

(7-65) "This is Patrol One, everything's quite in Sector Two. Over."

Russian Guard 3

Relaxed and easygoing manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – Guard 3 and 4 can be seen in a Figure shot. In the background the tipster proceeds on.]

(7-66) "As soon as we are gone I share with you a bottle of Vodka."

Russian Guard 4

Relaxed and easygoing manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – Same recording as before.]

(7-67) "Sounds good, comrade."

Patrol 3 (Soldier 1)

A little displeased manner of speaking with a reproachful undertone.

[Russian accent – Both guards of patrol 3 can be seen in a Wide shot from behind.]

(7-68) "I hope they are finished loading soon! I am really bored."

Patrol 3 (Soldier 2)

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – Same recording as before.]

(7-69) "Yeah, me too."

Pablo Garcia

Serious and worried manner of speaking (almost whispering).

[via radio – The tipster can be seen in a Full shot from the front how he crouches besides a container.]

(7-70) "Homeland, can you hear me? Over."

Command Center

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[via radio – Same recording as before.]

(7-71) "This is Homeland, loud and clear. Over."

Pablo Garcia

Serious and worried manner of speaking (almost whispering).

[via radio – Same recording as before.]

(7-72) "Tarantula's cover was blown. The parcel is on its way, destination unknown. Over."

Command Center

Normal commanding tone.

[via radio – The tipster can be seen in a Full Shot from behind (right side).]

(7-73) "Homeland affirmative. Stay on radio and try to move forward to your exfiltration point."

Pablo Garcia

Serious and worried manner of speaking (almost whispering).

[via radio – Pablo Garcia can be seen straight from behind and starts to walk shortly onwards.]

(7-74) "All right, keep your fingers crossed for me!"

Russian Headquarter

Normal commanding tone.

[Russian accent, via radio – Soldier 2 of patrol 3 can be seen in a Figure shot from the right how he walks along a jetty.]

(7-75) "Attention, all units: Cover is blown! An American spy has killed a guard..."

[Russian accent, via radio – Soldier 1 of patrol 3 can be seen in a Figure shot from behind (right side) how he passes by a hall.]

(7-76) "...and has to be stopped at any price!"

Pablo Garcia

Serious manner of speaking, with a noticeable worry in his voice.

[via radio – You can see Pablo Garcia standing in a container.]

(7-77) "Fuck, I'm busted!"

Russian Guard 6

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – The two guards walk towards each other and then stand still.]

(7-78) "I go into the hall and take a look around there."

Normal commanding tone.

[Russian accent – The two guards can be seen in a Medium close-up.]

(7-79) "You check on the surroundings."

Russian Guard 5

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Russian accent – Same recording as before.]

(7-80) "Roger that."

Russian Guard 6

Speaks clearly and with insistence.

[Russian accent – The guard 6 surprises the tipster and apprehends him in the hall.]

(7-81) "Freeze and drop the gun!"

Russian Guard 7

Tense and hectic manner of speaking.

[Russian accent, via radio – Guard 7 stands before the hall and hears the shots.]

(7-82) "Damn, that guy wanna scoot."

Russian Headquarter

Normal commanding tone.

[Russian accent, via radio – Pablo Garcia kills both Russian guards and flees.]

(7-83) "Guard Four, what's your status?" [quick break, white noise as sound effect] "Guard Four, come in please!"

Russian Guard 3

Speaks a little snidely and with insistence.

[Russian accent, via radio – Pablo Garcia is on the run.]

(7-84) "There he is, that little fucker – Sector One Six."

[Russian accent, via radio – The Russian guard 3 has spotted the tipster and opens fire.]

(7-85) "Hold on, I'm gonna get you!"

Pablo Garcia

Tense and hectic manner of speaking.

[via radio – The tipster is being shown how he walks up to a car wreckage.]

(7-86) "Homeland, they almost got me!"

Russian Guard 3

Speaks clearly and with insistence.

[Russian accent, via radio – The Russian guard 3 runs for the tipster and shoots.]

(7-87) "Damn, he is about to scam. Leaves Sector One Two."

Patrol 3 (Soldier 1)

Effusive, lively manner of speaking.

[Russian accent, via radio – Pablo Garcia gets shot while being on the run.]

(7-88) "I've finished this bastard!"

Command Center

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[via radio – You can see the dead body of the tipster and afterwards his hidden ATV. After this, fadeout to black.]

(7-89) "Tarantula, please come in." [quick break, white noise as sound effect] "Tarantula, how copy?"

American Soldier

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Colonel Maxwell stands at the beach and the soldier walks towards him.]

(7-90) "Sir, all Humvees are ready to go."

Colonel Maxwell

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Same recording as before.]

(7-91) "Great."

American Soldier

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Same recording as before.]

(7-92) "Besides that, Command Center made contact."

Colonel Maxwell

Normal commanding tone.

[Maxwell can be seen in a Close-up shot from the front.]

(7-93) "Report!"

American Soldier

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[The soldier can be seen in a Close-up shot from the front.]

(7-94) "Our tipster Pablo Garcia has been discovered in Panama and was probably killed. The Russians have loaded weapons on a container ship."

Colonel Maxwell

Thoughtful manner of speaking, but in normal voice pitch.

[The Colonel and the soldier can be seen in an American shot.]

(7-95) "A weapons transport from Panama? Arica Harbor can be the only target destination. What the hell are they planning? However, we have to go to Arica ... now."

Normal commanding tone.

[Colonel Maxwell and the soldier can be seen in a Close-up shot.]

(7-96) "Follow me!"

American Soldier

Speaks clearly and with a slight insistence.

[Same recording as before.]

(7-97) "Yes, Sir!"

Colonel Maxwell

Normal commanding tone.

[The Colonel goes to the entrance of the hall, on the right side of him there is a Humvee and the team is also to be seen.]

(7-98) "Get your gear, guys, we have to go to Arica!"

J. P. McClark

Relaxed and easygoing manner of speaking.

[Same recording as before.]

(7-99) "Finally, some work to do."

Colonel Maxwell

Normal commanding tone.

[Colonel Maxwell can be seen in a Close-up shot from the right.]

(7-100) "This time, failure is not an option."

[Jason, Francisco and the Colonel are being shown in a Full shot.]

(7-101) "We have to stop Sergey, do not disappoint me!"

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Both Humvees drive out of the hall.]

(7-102) "This is Colonel Maxwell, Command Center please come in! Over."

Command Center

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[The Humvees drive out of the hall and turn onto the street.]

(7-103) "This is Command Center. What can we do for you, Colonel? Over."

Colonel Maxwell

Normal voice pitch and manner of speaking.

[Both Humvees drive along the street.]

(7-104) "We are going to Arica. I expect Sergey's next target to be there. We will stop him before he can cause more damage. Over."

Command Center

Normal commanding tone.

[The Humvees leave the base.]

(7-105) "Copy that. You've got the go-ahead, Colonel. Over and out."
